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## Answer Key – Sample Responses

Suggested answers:

- 1. Grammar makes writing clear and easy to understand.
- 2. It might show carelessness or lack of attention to detail.
- 3. Correct: She doesn't like the movie because it was boring.
- 4. Example: 'Let's eat, grandma' vs 'Let's eat grandma' – punctuation changes meaning.
- 5. Grammar helps people understand your message clearly.
- 6. Corrected: They were playing soccer yesterday.
- 7. Correct answer: b) It's going to rain.
- 8. Grammar helps form correct sentences so others can understand you.
- 9. Example: The happy dog barked. ('happy' is the adjective)
